- NOTES:
- Standards are applicable to the unincorporated area under the jurisdiction of the Board of County Commissioners.
 - Any proposed relocation, extension or improvement of U.S. 50 or S.R. 32 west of Interstate 275 shall not be classified as a freeway, turnpike or limited access highway and no extension of I-74 is recommended through the Anderson Township / Newtown area.
 - ODOT (Ohio Department of Transportation) Journalized Alignments identify the official position of the Director of Transportation. ODOT is authorized to protect such recorded alignments from development by acquisition of property within 300 feet of the centerline and 500 feet from the intersections.
 - The travel corridors identified on this plan are areas where congestion management studies by OKI are needed prior to making final recommendations on roadway classifications and alignments. The recommendation in designated corridors may require substantial amendment following evaluation of multimodal and intermodal alternatives and coordination with the Regional Transportation Plan.
