

NOTICE OF ELECTION
CITY OF CINCINNATI
AN ORDINANCE NO. 238-2009
EMERGENCY
ISSUE EIGHT

TO SUBMIT to the electors of the City of Cincinnati an amendment to the Charter of the City to prevent the transfer or sale of any assets of the City of Cincinnati, or any of its boards or commissions, to any regional water district, or any regional water and sewer district, formed pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Chapter 6119 without first submitting the question of the approval of such transfer or sale of assets to a vote of the electorate of the City and receiving a majority affirmative vote for the same, by enacting new Article XV.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cincinnati, State of Ohio, two-thirds of the members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That there shall be submitted to the vote of the qualified electors of the City of Cincinnati for their approval or disapproval at the general election to be held November 3, 2009, an amendment to the Charter of the City of Cincinnati, enacting new Article XV thereof, to read as follows:

Article XV.

**PREVENTION OF THE TRANSFER OR SALE OF ANY ASSETS OF THE
CITY OF CINCINNATI, OR ANY OF ITS BOARDS OR COMMISSIONS,
TO ANY REGIONAL WATER DISTRICT, OR ANY REGIONAL WATER
AND SEWER DISTRICT, FORMED PURSUANT TO OHIO REVISED
CODE CHAPTER 6119**

That the city of Cincinnati, and its various boards and commissions, may not transfer or sell any assets of the City of Cincinnati, or any of its boards or commissions, to any regional water district, or any regional water and sewer district, formed pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Chapter 6119 without first submitting the question of the approval of such transfer or sale of assets to a vote of the electorate of the city and receiving a majority affirmative vote for the same.

Section 2. That the form of submission of the proposed amendment to the electors shall be substantially as follows:

<p>YES</p>	<p>Shall the Charter of the City of Cincinnati be amended to prohibit the city, and its various boards and commissions, from transferring or selling any assets of the City of Cincinnati, or any of its boards or commissions, to any regional water district, or any regional water and sewer district, formed pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Chapter 6119, without first submitting the question of the approval of such transfer or sale of assets to a vote of the electorate of the City and receiving a majority affirmative vote for the same, by enacting new Article XV?</p>

Section 3. That the Clerk of Council shall give notice of the proposed Charter Amendment in the manner provided by Sections 8 and 9 of Article XVIII of the Ohio Constitution and Section 731.211 (B) of the Ohio Revised Code.

Section 4. That the Clerk of Council is directed to certify and transmit to the Board of Elections of Hamilton County, Ohio, a copy of this ordinance and direct the said Board to submit the proposed Charter amendment to the electors of the City of Cincinnati as provided by law.

Section 5. That the Board of Elections of Hamilton County, Ohio, shall certify to the Council the result of the vote upon said amendment, and if said amendment is approved by a

majority of the electors voting thereon, Article XV shall become a part of the Charter of the City of Cincinnati.

Section 6. That this ordinance shall be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and general welfare and shall, subject to the terms of Article II, Section 6 of the Charter, be effective immediately. The reason for the emergency is the immediate necessity to authorize the Clerk of Council to certify and transmit this ordinance to the Board of Elections at least sixty days prior to the November 3, 2009 general election.
