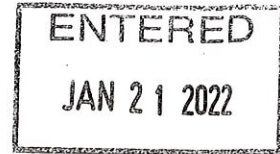

ENTRY AND ORDER OF DECORUM

The Administrative Judge of the Court of Common Pleas of Hamilton County, Ohio, Division of Domestic Relations hereby finds that it is in the best interest of all parties coming to be heard in the Division of Domestic Relations, that this entry and order of decorum be issued.

Wherefore, it is hereby ordered that all parties appearing before this Court shall be dressed appropriately and in a respectful manner. All parties shall be respectful to each other and the Court. Video and/or audio recordings in the courtroom are NOT permitted except upon the express written permission of the Judicial Officer.

Pursuant to the Hamilton County Declaration of Emergency dated January 11, 2022, capacity in courtrooms is limited. Capacity is determined by the number of people who can safely fit in each courtroom while maintaining social distancing. This determination will be made individually and as necessary by the Administrative Judge, any duly elected Judge, and/or any Magistrate of this Court.

Any violation of this order may result in contempt of Court, the punishment for which could include fines of up to \$250.00 and/or up to thirty days in jail for each offense.
