





UC Online provides Enrollment Services Advisors and Student Success Coordinators who understand the demands of a busy life.



Student Success Coordinators

UC Online has a team of Student Success Coordinators on hand to help support students as they go through their academic journey. Some of their responsibilities include:

- A welcome call once you have been accepted into the program to get to know you and your education goals.
- Several check-ins per semester to ensure you are progressing as planned and to help resolve any issues.
- If needed, they can be a liaison between you and the faculty to ensure you are able to achieve the best possible outcome.
- Helping you seamlessly manage any potential technical issues with the online platform.
- Any other potential questions throughout your time at UC Online.





Frequently Asked Questions

Will my degree say UC Online?

No. Your degree will be conferred by the University of Cincinnati, which will also be reflected on your transcripts and degree.

Can I work while completing this program?

Yes. The vast majority of our students work throughout their time in their academic program. It is important to assess course loads and financial aid to understand how to balance school and work.

Can I complete the program part-time?

Programs can be completed full-time or part-time. Many programs are set up to be part-time, with most containing fewer than 10 credit hours in any given semester. We know you have a lot going on, so we want to make sure that school can fit into your schedule. Note: There are some exceptions.

What is the format for the classes?

Classes are asynchronous, some classes are in a 7-week format, some are in a 14-week format. You can log on anytime, 24/7, to complete your coursework. Some, but not all, tests are proctored using exam proctoring software.

Will I need to be on-campus in Cincinnati at any point during the program?

Yes, to walk across the stage for your graduation. (Just kidding, that is optional!)

Is this school and my program accredited?

The University of Cincinnati is a regionally accredited school which is the highest level of accreditation possible. For specific program accreditation details please see your program information pages. There are different organizational accreditations as well.


Can I still apply if my previous school was not regionally accredited?

Yes. UC will conduct a general education requirement to check to make sure you have all of the necessary courses. Anything that doesn't meet the UC general education requirement will need to be taken again.

What if my GPA is slightly below the minimum? Do I still have a chance to get accepted?

Yes. There is a chance if certain conditions are met. These could include taking a graduate entry exam (i.e. GRE, GMAT), being conditionally admitted, or working with the program director on other ways to demonstrate your likelihood for success if admitted into the program.
