Hamilton County Alcohol and Drug Addiction Services appoints Judge Deidra Hair to Board

CINCINNATI—The Hamilton County Alcohol and Drug Addiction Services (ADAS) Board (<http://www.hamilton-co.org/adas/>) recently appointed Judge Deidra Layne Hair to its Board of Trustees.

Judge Hair, retired, is a resident of Mariemont, and served on the Hamilton County Court of Common Pleas from 1995 until February 2001. Her professional experiences include serving as a judge with the First District Court of Appeals and the Hamilton County Municipal Court, an attorney with the firm of Rice & Ladrigan, and as a professor with the University of Cincinnati. Judge Hair has also volunteered for several area addiction services programs, and helped create numerous municipal alcohol and drug treatment programs.

The Hamilton County Alcohol and Drug Addiction Services (ADAS) Board plans, funds, and evaluates public alcohol and drug treatment, prevention, and education services for the citizens of Hamilton County.
