AN ADDITIONAL TAX OF 0.34 MILL

at a rate not exceeding 0.34 mills for each one dollar of valuation, which amounts

to (\$0.034) for each one hundred dollars of valuation, (Rate expressed in dollars and cents)

for FIVE (5) YEARS, COMMENCING IN 2009, FIRST DUE IN CALENDAR YEAR 2010 (Number of years the levy is to run, life of indebtedness, or "continuing period of time")
