## **HUNLEY ROAD CLOSURE**

**\*\*\* Between Clough Road & Spinningwheel Lane\*\*\*  
**IN ANDERSON TOWNSHIP****

William W. Brayshaw, the Hamilton County Engineer, would like to announce that Hunley Road, between Clough Road and Spinningwheel Lane, in Anderson Township, will be closed to thru traffic, beginning Monday, September 21, 2009; for a period of twenty-eight (28) days.

This is for the first phase of water main installation being installed for GCWW by Carter Construction, which is anticipated to last until December 21, 2009 (weather permitting).
