## Population Change - Region 2000 - 2004 Proportional Change

CINCINNATI METROPOLITAN STATISTICAL AREA

The proportional change is calculated using the following formula: Jurisdiction X's 2004 percentage share of the total CMSA population minus Jurisdiction X's 2000 percentage share of the total CMSA population. For example, 16.7% of the region's population lived in the city of Cincinnati in 2000 compared to 15.5% in 2004. Thus, the proportional change is -1.2%. Conversely, Unincorporated Boone County, the region's largest gainer, experienced a proportional share of +0.5%.
