POLICY AND PROCEDURES OF THE OFFICE OF THE HAMILTON COUNTY ENGINEER REGARDING APPLICATION FOR ANNUAL PERMITS TO MOVE EXCESSIVE LOADS OR EQUIPMENT ON OR OVER HAMILTON COUNTY ROADS AND BRIDGES

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The following procedures described the Policy of the Office of the Hamilton County Engineer regarding annual permits for moving excessive loads or equipment on or over Hamilton County Roads and Bridges within the unincorporated areas of Hamilton County, Ohio, and shall be in effect until amended by the Board of Hamilton County Commissioners.

PROCEDURES

1. A person, firm or agency desiring to move excessive loads or equipment on or over highways and bridges under the jurisdiction of the Hamilton County Engineer shall make application on a prescribed form (see Exhibit #1-A, #1-B, #1-C. The application must be signed by the person or a principle of the firm or agency responsible for the movement of the excessive load or equipment involved in the application. The application shall be delivered to the Hamilton County Engineer's Permit Office located at 223 West Galbraith Road, Cincinnati, OH 45215, Phone No. (513) 761-7400. (Application forms are available at this location.)

NOTE: Facsimile transmittal/receipt of the application will be acceptable.

- 2. The applicant shall also supply with the application a signed Certificate of Liability Insurance which includes the Hamilton County Engineer as the certificate holder and Hamilton County and its employees as additional insured party (see Exhibit #2).
- 3. In addition, the applicant shall provide detailed information regarding the following: (a) requested effective dates, overall height, length, width and weight of the excessive load or equipment; (b) number of axles, and axle spacing. (See Exhibit #1-A.)
- 4. If the move involves also a Ohio Department of Transportation Permit, a copy of such permit shall be attached which shall include the following information; (a) effective permit dates; (b) overall height, length, width and weight and; (c) number of axles and axle spacings (see Exhibit #3).
- 5. Upon receipt of the Annual Permit application by the Office of the Hamilton County Engineer, a determination shall be made that all the required information listed in 1, 2, and 3 above is in proper form, including the necessary and proper signatures.
- 6. Facsimile copies of the load dimension, weights and axle spacings shall be forwarded to the Bridge Engineer and the Traffic Supervisor for review, comment and concurrence.
- 7. Upon receipt of the reports from the Bridge Engineer and the Traffic Supervisor with no objections to the applicant's requested routing and time for the move, the applicant will be advised by the Permit Office that approval will be granted. A signed copy of the approval will be immediately sent to the applicant.

- 8. In instances where objections are offered or special conditions are advised by the Bridge Engineer (see Exhibit #1-B and 1-C) or the Traffic Supervisor; alternate routes, alternate times, adjustment of loads/axles, will be discussed with the applicant and adjustments made as necessary to the permit. This negotiation shall occur between steps #6 and #7 in the procedures. In all cases, the right is reserved by the Hamilton County Engineer to disapprove moving excessive loads or equipment over Hamilton County Roads and Bridges within his jurisdiction.
- 9. The Permit Office will then notify the various agencies and persons as appropriate and as listed on the Notification List (see Exhibit #4). A copy of the completed notification list dated and signed shall become part of the record of the matter.
 - 10. Complete files of all documentation regarding applications for actual "moves" shall be maintained in the Permit Office at 223 West Galbraith Road, Cincinnati, OH 45215.

NOTE: This Annual Permit applies <u>ONLY</u> to Hamilton County Roads. Contractor hereby assumes all responsibility for damages to roads and structures while moving on subject roads. Permission is hereby granted provided Applicant complies with the provisions of Section 4513.34, Ohio Revised Code and the following Special Provisions Applying to Hamilton County Annual Permits (page two) and Hamilton County Exceptions (page three).

SPECIAL PROVISIONS APPLYING TO HAMILTON COUNTY ANNUAL PERMITS

- 1. Permittee is responsible to check the route for abnormal or changed or unknown conditions which may exist during any move. Permission to travel State or Township Roads or City Streets not a part of the County Highway System and must be obtained from proper authorities.
- 2. Permit is valid for points intermediate to routes listed. (See Hamilton County Exceptions for Annual Permits, Page Three.)
- 3. Movement shall be made during daylight hours and not during periods of high traffic volumes. No movement shall be made on Saturday, Sunday or Holiday.
- 4. A copy of the approved application shall be kept in the vehicle involved in the move at all times during the "move" and shall be produced upon request of proper authority.
- 5. Permittee will be held liable for any damage caused by the movement. The County assumes no responsibility for damage to the Permittee's equipment or load being moved due to any such failure. The Permittee agrees to compensate Hamilton County for any damage to a roadway or road structure and also to hold Hamilton County harmless from all responsibility for personal injury or property damages (public or private) caused directly or indirectly as a result of the transportation of said vehicle(s) or object(s).
- 6. The applicant must file a bond or certificate of his liability insurance, showing that he has procured adequate bond or insurance to cover the provisions of Paragraph 5.
- 7. No vehicle(s) or object(s) being transported under special highway permit shall be left parked on the roadway either day or night except in case of an emergency, in which case adequate protection shall be provided for the traveling public. The vehicle(s) shall not be loaded or unloaded within the limits of the highway.
- 8. All construction equipment and other machinery shall have attached thereto a plate showing the manufacturer's name and the model.
- 9. A permit is void at any time road, weather or traffic conditions make travel unsafe.
- 10. Oversize or overweight loads shall be operated or moved at such speeds and in such manner as to cause a minimum of interference with other traffic and minimum impact stresses on structures or pavements. No such movement is to exceed 40 miles per hour at any time, except upon that portion of a highway where the posted minimum speed is in excess of 40 miles per hour. The allowable maximum then becomes equivalent to the minimum posted speed.
- 11. Non-compliance with the general or special provisions of a permit, exceeding the weights or dimensions granted, or operating on dates or upon highways other than assigned shall render the permit null and void and the operator of the vehicle subject to arrest, as provided in Section 5577.02 to 5577.05, inclusive, of the Revised Code of Ohio.
