ODOT update:

- Tom Arnold reported in detail on the "Update of ODOT Major Projects in the Downtown Cincinnati Area" report. A copy of the "Update of ODOT Major Projects in the Downtown Cincinnati Area" handout was distributed, which is attached hereto and made a part of.
- Tom Arnold reported on the Brent Spence Bridge funding applications. They are waiting on the decision of these applications. The total cost of the project is approximately 3 billion dollars. They will be requesting for proposals in January 2023.
- Tom Arnold stated they will be doing supplemental and environmental assessments and Community Outreach meetings as part of the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA).

- Tom Arnold commented on the new Diversity Inclusion Outreach Committee that started on November 7, 2022. This committee is aimed at engaging DBE's and Workforce Development as well as on the job training opportunities.

TID Corridors of Opportunity...

• Board Member Beck reported they are continuing to work on the Dry Fork Road project. They did receive additional funding and are working towards getting a contract for the design completion.

Western Hills Viaduct update:

- Bill Shefcik reported they received statement qualifications from Contractors with interest on becoming a Construction Manager at Risk. They should have a final selection by early next year.
- Bill Shefcik reported in December, the City of Cincinnati will be bidding a second demolition project on Spring Grove Avenue, site of the new Duke Substation.
- Bill Shefcik reported in early next year the City will be requesting qualifications for an Independent Cost Estimator to work with the Construction Manager at Risk.
- Bill Shefcik reported that Duke Energy is actively in the design of their relocated transmission line and substation north of the existing bridge.

Cincinnati Transportation Update...

 Board Member Brazina reported the City of Cincinnati received funding from OKI for the Gilbert Avenue project, from Court Street to Martin Luther King. They are going to combine this project with some urban paving projects with ODOT. They also received funding for a trail project over the Little Miami Scenic Trail near Beechmont Avenue.

- Andy Aiello SORTA reported that the Reinventing Metro continues in the fixed route bus service. There are new service changes and updates that go into effect December 4, 2022.
- Andy Aiello reported that Mobility on Demand (Metro Now) continues. Two pilot zones identified are the Springdale zone and the Northgate/Mt. Healthy zone. Looking at launching these the first quarter of 2023.
- Andy Aiello reported the BRT planning work continues. There are 4 corridors that are identified for evaluation with the Consultants and Stake Holders: Glenway, Hamilton, Reading and Montgomery.
